🌸 THIS YEAR'S TALENT

BARE NECESSITIES, a quartet known for its creative interpretations of English country dance tunes, has been playing together since 1980. Earl Gaddis and Mary Lea both play violin and viola, Kate Barnes is on winds and guitar, and Jacqueline Schwab plays piano. Together they have redefined the sound of English country dance music with an improvisatory and playful style that reflects their classical background and extensive experience playing for all kinds of dancing. Their music spans the centuries from 16th century Early Music to recently-composed pieces and their improvisation makes for a dynamic interweaving of harmonies and countermelodies. The group has inspired dancers and audiences from Hawaii to York, England, from Alaska to St. Croix, VI. In the course of their long association, they have made an impressive 18 recordings.

JOANNA REINER has taught English country dance for nearly two decades. In addition to being one of the leaders of the Philadelphia-based Germantown Country Dancers, her calling has taken her around the globe from Amherst to Ann Arbor, from St. Croix to Hawaii to Florence, Italy. While known for her clear calling and instruction, Joanna is also an avid dance gypsy, and in her spare time, works to support her dance habit.
