### 🌸 THIS YEAR'S TALENT

JOSEPH PIMENTEL is a popular caller at dance events throughout the country and further afield. His calling combines clear teaching, discriminating taste in dances and respect for tradition. He is also the composer of many beloved English Country Dances and has published two booklets, The Cardinal and Goldcrest Collections.

California based but internationally known multi-instrumentalist SHIRA KAMMEN has spent well over half her life exploring early music and other intriguing styles and has been a member of countless early music groups, English Country and Balkan bands, Shakespeare Festival orchestras and is the founder of Class V Music, an ensemble dedicated to providing music on river rafting trips.

DAVE WIESLER is a nationally recognized accompanist for Scottish, English country dance, contra dance, waltz & swing dance. He has played at numerous music and dance camps and festivals across the country, as well as in Canada, Scotland, England, France, and onboard a ship traveling the waters of the Galápagos Islands. A music teacher, guitarist and singer, he is also a prolific composer of over 300 tunes, songs, solo piano pieces, choral arrangements, and even a few classical pieces arranged for small orchestra.

Nashville's SUSAN KEVRA is a clarinetist and English, contra and square dance caller who has traveled the globe sharing those passions with dancers. She has recently begun composing English Country dances that have made their way onto ball programs across the country. Susan brings her deep knowledge of English country dancing to her playing, with a keen awareness of what's needed to make a tune work.
